The Setup:

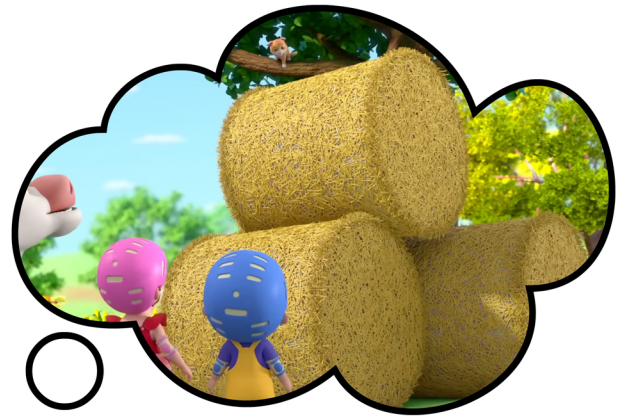
Place a small stuffed animal (like a toy kitty) on a slightly elevated surface, such as a sturdy table, a couch cushion, or a low table.

The Goal:

Challenge the children to build a safe "bridge" or "ladder" to rescue the kitty using safe household items, just like Emma and Joey did!

Visual Reference:
