

## "The Phonics Prop Box!!"



### How to Use This Page

#### Step 1: Watch and Mimic:

Play the embedded video above. Encourage your child to copy Johny and Jiny's exaggerated facial expressions and hand gestures for each letter sound.

#### Step 2: Follow the Lyrics:

Read through the on-page lyrics together. Point to the words as you sing along to build print awareness and word-object recognition.

**Step 3: Move and Groove:** When the chorus hits, physically get up! Jump around during the transition breaks to keep your child engaged and excited.

**Step 4: Practice Offline:** Pick a few letters a day from our lyrics sheet and try to find matching items around your house or classroom (e.g., finding a real B for Ball, or O for Orange).

## The Set-Up:

Place your "Phonics Prop Box" next to the screen or device. Keep the flash cards inside the box.



## Watch for the Cue:

Play the video. Let your child sing along until a letter they are practicing comes up.



## Visual Reference:

Just like Johny and Jiny pull out a physical prop or use a hand gesture in the video, you (or your child) will reach into your box and pull out the corresponding item right as the song says it. \* For example, when the song hits " A for Apple Ah-Ah. Ah-Apple", dramatically pull the flash card out of the box, hold it up next to the screen.

## The Echo Challenge:

Pause the video after that letter, have your child hold the flash card, and repeat the phonetic sound three times while looking at the object.

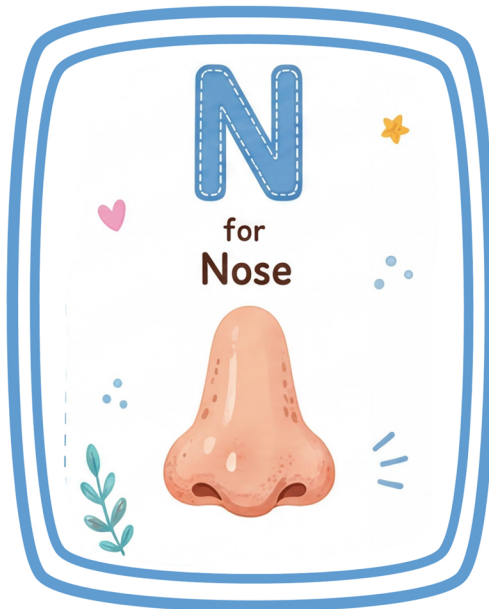

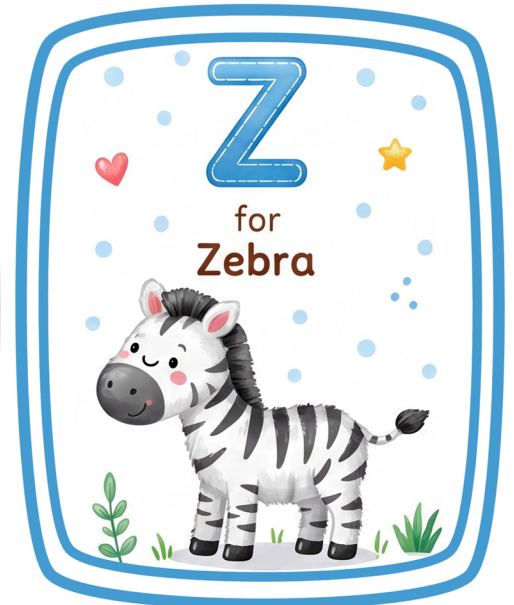
